

Higher Raises at the Top

ASEE conducts an annual engineering faculty salary survey. From 2007 to 2012, between 110 and 150 schools participated in the survey each year. Below are box-and-whisker plots that show approximate distributions of faculty salaries for all engineering disciplines for all schools that participated. Salaries are equivalent nine-month salaries for tenured or tenure-track faculty. Longitudinally, shown in the graphic below, engineering faculty salaries increased from 2007 to 2009, decreased slightly from 2009 to 2010, and increased from 2010 to 2012. In general, senior faculty received higher raises than their more junior counterparts.
