fall engineering faculty in tenured and tenure-track positions nationwide, African-American women represent just 0.52 percent. The 338 U.S. four-year degree-granting engineering schools members as of the fall of 2017. Of these institutions, 81 collectively reported a total of 142 tenured members as of the fail of 2017 . Of these institutions, 8 coliectively reporiee a totas of 142 tenemale faculty, including non-tenure-track as well as tenured and tenure-track, the proportion of AfricanAmericans had climbed from 2.1 percent in 2001 to 3.1 percent in 2017, but remained well below the proportions of white, Asian, and Hispanic women. The three institutions with the highest number of tenured and tenure-track African-American female faculty were the University of Florida, with seven, Morgan State University, with six, and Howard Were the University of Forida, with seven, Morgan State University, with six, and Howard five institutions had full professors who were African-American women.
